### 2025 Financial Results

Thanks to you, our many generous participants, and our wonderful Matching Grant Donor Duly Health and Care Charitable Fund, Celebrating Women, Transforming Lives raised \$153,803 with a net of \$131,111 – which is 7% above what we budgeted and almost 30% more than last year! That's enough to house 10 families for one full year! We couldn't have done it without you!

Your sponsorship was key to maximizing our net income and optimizing our ability to impact the lives of the resilient families Bridge serves.

The more sponsor dollars we have the more funds go directly to the bottom line. We hope you will continue your support of this beloved, inspirational event in 2026 and beyond!
